- Networking with other specialists in this field

The Requirements for this role are:

- Qualified, experienced teacher (minimum 2 years' experience, HOD preferable)
- A minimum of 3 years' experience of coaching teachers
- Ability to support SP/FET teachers of all subjects through classroom observation and the facilitation of PLCs (preference will be given to applicants with strong experience teaching Mathematics or Physical Sciences)
- Knowledge of education theories and their practical applications in the context of the Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement (CAPS)
- Ability to conduct lesson observations and to provide meaningful feedback to SP and FET teachers of all subjects
- Knowledge of the rural public school system and the ability to imagine professional development in this context (experience working in rural areas would be an asset)
- Strong facilitation skills and the ability to run professional learning communities (PLCs).
 (Facilitation, mentoring and/or coaching certificate is an added advantage)
- Strong analytical mind, able to organise data and engage in evidence based conversations
- Strong computer skills with ability to use MS Office, Google, Zoom, etc.
- The ideal candidate should have a working knowledge of isiXhosa
- Be fluent in both written and spoken English
- Drivers license
